This has reference to your application dated 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2013, 9<sup>th</sup> May, 2013 and 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2014, requesting for permission to start new B. Ed. degree college from the academic year 2014-15 on the name of “**Siddharth B. Ed. College (English Medium)**” proposed to be started at N. S. Knowledge Centre, At - Boradpada, Post – Chargaon, Tal – Ambernath, Dist – Thane – 421 503.

In this connection, I am directed to inform you that considering the permission granted vide letter No. WRC/APP1586/199<sup>th</sup>/2014/113289, 91, 92, 93, 94, 95, 96, dated 27<sup>th</sup> January, 2014 by the National Council of Teacher Education, Bhopal, No Objection Certificate bearing No. बीएड-४६१४/प्र.क.२८/१४/मशि-२, दिनांक २५ फेब्रुवारी, २०१४ issued by the Higher & Technical Education Department, Mantralay, Mumbai as well as the Regional Joint Director, Konkan Vibhag, Panvel vide No. सहसं/उशि/कोविप/मशि.३/विअतु/२०१४/३२०, दिनांक ४ मार्च, २०१४ and approval of the teachers of your college by the University vide letters No. CONCOL/S/ECD/13-14/20272, dated 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2013 & CONCOL/S/ECD/13-14/38300, dated 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2014 and the Principal's approval vide letter No. CONCOL/ISA/3063 of 2013, dated 8<sup>th</sup> November, 2013, your Society has been permitted to start new B. Ed. degree college & enroll the students with intake 100 students from the academic year 2014-15, on the name of Siddharth B. Ed. College (English Medium) at N. S. Knowledge Centre, At - Boradpada (Aadivasi Remote Area), Post – Chargaon, Tal – Ambernath, Dist – Thane – 421 503, on permanently “**No Grant Basis**”, subject to satisfactory report of the Local Inquiry Committee of the University.


The college has also to fulfill the conditions mentioned in the above referred Government Resolutions and also to fulfill the following affiliation conditions –

- 1) that the conditions laid down by the University from time to time.
- 2) that the minimum attendance of all the students must not be less than 75% during the academic year and college will have to complete syllabus of all the subjects during the academic year.
- 3) admissions should not be linked with donations.
- 4) that the college will strictly follow the Ordinance 2802 in respect of preventing the colleges and Management of Colleges from accepting donation or capitation fees for admission of students in the Colleges, quoted in the University Circular No.Aff./Recog./49 of 1987, dated 4<sup>th</sup> February, 1987 (copy enclosed.)
- 5) that college should follow the norms as prescribed and circulated by the University vide No.CONCOL/75 of 1988, dated 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 1988 (copy enclosed).
- 6) the college shall not admit the students over and above sanctioned intake.
- 7) the college shall appoint the teaching as well as non-teaching faculty as per the University and U.G.C. norms and also provide infrastructure facilities for the

Further, if it is observed that 50% or less students admitted as per sanctioned intake, the action of de affiliation will be initiated against the college.

You are further informed that in case you could not start the college from the academic year 2014-15, the permission granted to your Mandal/Trust/Society will stands cancelled automatically, which may please be noted.
